Hoshea (Moses changed to Joshua: Saviour/deliverer), 11 men in OT,

Jesus the very thought of thee (St. Bernard)

Jesus is an Enduring Name:

2000 years, born in obscurity, died as a criminal at 33, yet age to age he has be the central figure. The irony of Christmas is those who oppose his all year round march to the tune of His birthday celebration once a year!

Jesus Lover of my Soul

Jesus is an Exalted Name:

Ephesians 1:20-21 read, Philippians 2:9-11 read.

At the Name of Jesus every knee should bow...

Jesus is an Exclusive Name:

'You shall give Him the Name Jesus (because He will save His people from their sins)'. Joshua of OT/would-be saviour's today/ pastors can't save you from sin: only Jesus alone can. Salvation is not found in M/U/B/Cath/CE/Charis: it's found alone in Jesus.
