

Learning from the breadth of Bible teaching, and looking especially at the example and teaching of Jesus, we will explore how Christians today can know the presence and power of the Holy Spirit themselves. Through Biblical teaching, discussion, practical experience and thoughtful reflection, you can grow in:

- Understanding who the Holy Spirit is
- Grasping four key works of the Holy Spirit
- Seeing how Jesus cooperated with the Spirit
- Being filled with the Holy Spirit for service
