From followers to leaders But they need help: Warnings Kicked out of the Synagogues (Churches) [△] 16:2 Threat of being killed [△] 16:2-3 by those who believe that they worship God in this way But they do not know the Father or Jesus The Holy Spirit or Advocate **Paraclete** Helper, comforter, empowerer, companion, advocate, intercessor all these things and more Work of the Spirit in this passage 1. Replaces Jesus Needed as the Spirit can be everywhere and engage with everyone Jesus in human form can only interact with people in his vincinity 2. Prove the world wrong about sin, righteousness and judgement Sin: not believing in Jesus! Righteousness: Jesus taught righteousness and challenged injustice. Now the Spirit will do that on his behalf [△] v10

Judgement: The ruler of this world (Satan) is condemned, and so are the practices he inspires 3. Guides us in all Truth [△] v13 The Spirit speaks on behalf of Jesus who speaks on behalf of the Father 4.
